

Body Sculpting Using Laser Liposuction

MILFORD — Did you know that you can lose as much as one gallon of fat with each liposculpture session, a procedure that removes and sculpts fat while you are awake? If you have areas of fat that will not respond to diet and exercise, then laser liposuction may be a great choice for you.

Dr. Richard E. Buckley of MilfordMD Advanced Dermatology Surgery and Cosmetic Laser Center in Milford, PA says “the Laser Liposuction Body Sculpting is a fantastic option for people who want to eliminate unwanted fat, get a more toned look and address specific problem areas. All procedures at MilfordMD are performed in on-site office based procedure rooms utilizing FDA approved devices and utilize the benefits of tumescent numbing of

treatment areas.

We use safe local tumescent anesthesia instead of general anesthesia, so the patient is awake and comfortable. The fat is gently melted by the laser and then removed using microcannular liposuction. Stitches are not needed and people typically return to work in a couple of days. Since the fatty cells are dissolved and cannot reproduce, the reduction in total fat cell number is believed to be permanent. The liposculpting lasers also tighten skin, so you are less likely to have loose sagging areas after the fat has been removed.”

Dr. Buckley says “Laser Liposculpting is ideal for a wide variety of problem areas such as a paunch or rolls in the tummy area, saddle bags, inner thigh problems or a double chin. Laser Liposuc-

tion is also used to treat the jaw line, neck, arms, hips, buttocks, knees and calves and for female and male breast reduction.

Do you exercise regularly but just can't seem to see the results you are looking for? Laser lipo can help sculpt away the fat above those six-pack abs you have been working so hard to achieve.

Living fat and stem cells that are removed during a liposculpting session can be used to augment other areas of the body such as the face, breasts and hands.

How much does laser liposuction cost?

Decisions about liposuction should not be based merely on cost. Laser Liposculpture is a hand-crafted art form which is different in every facility because each physician's approach to sculpting is unique. By meeting

with a surgeon you will come to understand his or her approach, skill, artistry and experience.

Laser liposuction must not be confused with traditional liposuction alone or laser lipo alone. It is the combination of a surgeon's artistry with specific lasers plus micro cannular liposuction that can give you the best result. Costs start at about \$5,000.

Reducing The Need For Glasses

SPARTA, NJ — Refractive surgery has achieved remarkable success in reducing the adult need for glasses and contact lenses, liberating patients to enjoy water and snow sports, recreational and daily work activities without the blur requiring prescription lenses. LASIK, using a laser to sculpt the corneal shape, allows a change of focus and improves vision without glasses.

Using a laser to create a special flap, the all-laser technique known as iLASIK provides safety and accuracy well beyond any previous method. This is the same procedure used by NASA and military aviation for their astronauts and pilots needing excellent vision without glasses. This same procedure is available in Sparta, New Jersey (30 minutes south of Milford) by Dr. Jeffrey Liegner, a Board Certified ophthalmology and Refractive Surgeon. Using highly sophisticated tools and custom measurements, which are then imported into the laser's programming, Dr. Liegner carefully performs the procedure in a State Certified surgery center, which enjoys pre-

cise temperature and humidity controls that enhance the laser's accuracy.

For patients with older eyes (needing reading glasses) and early cataracts that cause visual blur, the implantation of a multifocal intraocular lens (MFIOL) permits both excellent distance vision and very good reading/computer vision without glasses. Remarkably, 90% of patients receiving the MFIOL report never ever using glasses, and don't even own a pair of “cheaters.” Dr. Liegner frequently uses the MFIOL for his cataract patients, and occasionally combines LASIK with MFIOL for extreme prescriptions requiring a more complicated dual “bioptic” technique. Dr. Liegner's practice, located at 350 Sparta Ave in Sparta, offers FREE screening evaluations for patients consider a refractive procedure or who seek to know if they are a candidate for improved uncorrected vision (without glasses or contacts).
